Arrive Yangon

Upon arrival in Yangon, you will be privately driven to the Governor's Residence.

Governor's Residence (RL)

Similar to the other "luxury" hotels throughout Burma, the Governor's Residence is in need of renovation from the many years of economic sanctions levied on the country. That being said, this Victorian (teak) boutique former mansion is our favorite hotel in Yangon. Located in the leafy embassy district of the city, the rooms have a nice aesthetic with local Burmese wares displayed throughout. The Governor's Residence is a particularly special place in the evening, with the property and lush grounds illuminated.

Day 3

Yangon Private Tour

After breakfast, you will begin your private touring of Yangon in Burma. Botataung will be one of your first stops, with stunning golden interior. You will continue your tour with the following stopovers: Gems Museum, Scott Market with

outstanding local crafts, Musmeah Yeshua (the city's only synagogue), the famed Shwedagon Pagoda, and The Last Mughal's Tomb in Yangon.

Day 4

Fly Yangon/Inle Lake

Upon arrival at Mandalay Airport, you will be privately transferred to the Pristine Lotus Spa Resort. Inle is one of Burma's most picturesque places sitting on the Shan Plateau. You will be immersed into the unique methods of farming and fishing which sustain the local residents.

Prestine Lotus Spa & Resort

Located on a nicely landscaped hillside, accessible only by longboat, the Pristine Lotus property is our #2 preferred Inle Lake resort, on the occasion that Princess is full. Although the 49 split level chalets offer only partial lake views, the accommodations are spacious with updated amenities. Interestingly, a nearby hot spring provides hot water for all the chalets. Similar to the Inle Princess, Lotus has a very nice small spa and well-prepared restaurants. The Inle Princess is our favorite – that being said, there is not a big drop off when staying at the Lotus.

Day 5

Fly Inle Lake/Bagan

Upon arrival in Bagan, you will be privately transferred to Thiripyitsaya Sanctuary Resort and have the balance of the evening to enjoy the amenities of this place.

The Thiripyitsaya Sanctuary Resort

The Thiripyitsaya Sanctuary Resort is located on the banks of the Irrawaddy River overlooking 800 years of history. Once a Government VIP guest hotel, the Thiripyitsaya is now a collection of 70 bungalow rooms amid a beautiful setting of tropical gardens. Although we feel this is the very best nongovernment hotel in Bagan, the rooms are dated and not really deserving of a 5 star status. Nevertheless, as with other hotels in Burma, the service here is heartfelt and sincere.

Day 6

Bagan + Board for the Irrawaddy River Cruise

The sunrise hot air balloon ride is an experience that is not to be missed! We feel this balloon experience is among the best in Asia. You will board on the Irrawaddy River cruise navigating through the less accessible villages. During our last cruise on the Pandaw (2012), the two village stopovers were among the most interesting highlights of our entire Burma trip.

Irrawaddy River Cruise

Mandalay stands as one of the country's major cultural centers – nearly 60 percent of all monks in Myanmar reside in Mandalay. You will have the opportunity to visit the Shwenandaw Monastery, Mandalay Hill, and end with the truly unique 1.2 KM Ubein Teak Bridge.

Sedona Hotel Mandalay (RL)

This is the largest hotel (over 240 rooms) you will experience during your Burma private tour. Although registered as a 5 star hotel, the amenities and service more closely resemble that of a 4 star property. That being said, we feel that the Sedona Hotel's clean and comfortable atmosphere makes it the best hotel option in Mandalay

La Residence (RL)

This beautiful 34-room luxury property has been among the top two or three hotels in Luang Prabang for quite some time. Though its hillside location overlooking the city is a bit far from the main Luang Prabang area, we feel the atmosphere here is quite special and reminiscent of the early 20th century French-colonial era. Kudos to the very nice spa and the infinity pool. Bev and I feel the food here is simply outstanding—our meals at La Residence were perhaps our favorite in the city during our last stay here. As a reference point for the quality here, the Orient-Express folks operate and manage the hotel.

Luang Prabang

Raffles Grand Hotel D' Angkor (RL)

For the past several years Bev, Zen and I have felt the Raffles Grand Hotel D'Angkor to be our favorite hotel in all of Cambodia. Built in the early 1930's in the classic French-colonial style, the Raffles combines pampered and understated luxury with heartfelt Khmer service. You see very little staff turnover here as we see the same familiar smiling faces in each returning visit. Bev feels the string of shops at the hotel are most impressive in terms of quality and diversity (Cambodian and Laotian silks and artifacts). Zen loves the antique elevator and expansive pool, while I enjoy morning walks along the Raffles' 15 acre French Gardens. Please do not miss one of the evening Apsara Terrace buffet dinner/dance performances (every Monday, Wednesday, Friday)—an amazing experience!

The Temples of Angkor

Built during the height of the Khmer civilization from the 8th and 13th centuries, you will explore the ancient and lasting remains of this sacred site spanning 400 square kilometers.
