Notwithstanding the new luxury resorts opening up throughout Bali, Amandari is still our iconic favorite. Overlooking the Ayung River Gorge (nice for river-rafting!) near the artist's village of Ubud, the resort consists of 30 pavilion suites, many overlooking the adjacent lush, rice fields. Similar to other Aman locations, the Amandari has an amazing spa, wonderful food featuring local delicacies, and a well-stocked library. Of special note here is the spectacular 100 ft. infinity pool, set against the idyllic, green

environment.

Bali Discretionary Private Touring

Enjoy two days of Bali touring including a walk through the Ayung Valley. Beginning at 7:30 am, this walk takes you through padded rice fields, sacred springs, stone statues, and shrines, before ending with a picnic at Amandari's bale (a traditional Balinese rectangular open-sided pavilion with a steeply pitched thatch roof). Also, enjoy visits to the many Balinese temples including Pura Gunung Raung Taro, Para Samuan Tiga, Gunung Kiwa, Telaga Waja, Pura Gria Sakti, and Pura Ganung Lebah. Bali Rice Fields Touring

The Jatiluwih terraced rice fields are some of the most picturesque hikes on the entire island. Please note the eastern approach, north of Tabanan City, is the less-visited, most surreal route. Approx. an hour drive from Ubud. Jatiluwih is surrounded by a cool atmosphere, due to its location 2296 ft. above sea level. Jatiluwih is one of the World Heritage site's designated 14 Subak and 11 villages representing Bali's unique rice field managed irrigation system (Subak)
