Overview

When hiking a wide range of areas on the Patagonian Andes, it is easy to see how Torres del Paine still has hundreds of unvisited mountains, with many points inaccessible and unexplored. The features of Patagonia are remarkable: wild rivers, mostly rainforests, glaciated peaks, granite monoliths, and vast steppes. This is a place for reflection, deep solitude, and unforgettable outdoor activities.

We feel the splendid, stark wilderness of Chile's Atacama Desert rightly deserves a place among the world's notable natural wonders. Atacama's unmatched beauty and colorful moonscape-like remoteness is truly spellbinding. In the backdrop of spectacular volcanoes rising 25,000 feet, Atacama (covering 14,000 sq. miles) stretches 500 miles from Peru's southern border into northern Chile. Extraordinary full-day excursions here include the eerie, otherworldly Valley of the Moon, the Salt Flats of Tana, (featuring turquoise "oasis" with three types of flamingos living off the microscopic life), and the geysers of El Tatio.
